

Important Message for our Customers Regarding Electric Rates

On March 29TH, 2013 Granite State Electric Company d/b/a/ Liberty Utilities submitted a request to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) to raise the rates we charge for distribution of electric service.

If the PUC approves our request, the bill for a residential customer using 500 kWh of electricity per month will increase by approximately \$12.91. The increase for commercial and industrial customers will vary.

The PUC will conduct a comprehensive review of our request and the final decision may take up to a year to be rendered.
