Re: Pope Energy –RSA 363-A:5 Request for Exemption

Dear Ms Howland:

I am in receipt of your letter regarding the signing of Senate Bill 324 and the Public Utilities Commission Assessment Statute RSA 363-A.

Since Pope Energy is classified as an “assessed entity that is not an entity to which RSA 363-A:2, I (c) or (d) applies and that earned less than \$10,000 in gross revenue during the preceding fiscal year shall not be liable for any assessment pursuant to this chapter.”, we request such an exemption for our natural gas and electricity aggregators licenses.

Our aggregation business for commercial customers in New Hampshire is not as robust as we would prefer due to market forces and converting large commercial oil customers to compressed natural gas continues to be work in progress.
