Dear Mr. Rodier:

On May 3, 2013, Freedom Logistics, LLC d/b/a Freedom Energy Logistics (Freedom Energy Logistics) filed with the Commission an application for renewal of its registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the renewal application fee of \$125.00.

Commission Staff notes that Freedom Energy Logistics' original registration as an aggregator expires on May 31, 2013; only 28 days after Freedom Energy Logistics filed its renewal application with the Commission. Despite this oversight, Commission Staff has determined that the renewal application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05. On May 17, 2013, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the application, with the expectation that Freedom Energy Logistics will remain cognizant of Commission requirements for registration energy Logistics will remain cognizant of the registration with an effective date of June 1, 2013, which coincides with the expiration of the existing registration for Freedom Energy Logistics. The renewal registration will expire at the end of business on May 31, 2018.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal <u>at least 60 days</u> prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Freedom Energy Logistics, on or before <u>April 1, 2018</u>. <u>Please file a timely renewal application</u>.
