**Deficiency Letter** 

Dear Mr. Giery:

On May 9, 2013, Negawatt Business Solutions (Negawatt) submitted an application with the Commission to register as an electricity aggregator. Staff of the Commission reviewed your submission and has found issues that make your application incomplete. The following are issues Staff identified and the related N.H. Code of Admin. Rule requirement that must be met in order for your application to be complete.

1) Payment of filing fee for \$250.00 was not included with the application.

Puc 2003.04 Procedure for Initial Filing of Notice by Aggregators. (d) Except as provided in (e) below, payment of a filing fee of \$250.00.

2) Listing of the utility franchise areas in which Negawatt intends to operate is missing from the application.

Puc 2006.02 Form for Initial and Renewal Registration of Aggregators. (6) Description of the geographic areas of New Hampshire in which the applicant intends to provide service, consistent with Puc 2006.01(a)(10) above;

Regarding item #1, Staff is aware that Negawatt submitted an application to register as a gas aggregator and a check in the amount of \$250.00 under check number 24751. Staff applied check number 24751 towards the fee for Negawatt's application to register as a gas aggregator. Applications to operate as an aggregator in the electric and

gas industries are treated as separate applications. As such, an application fee must also be submitted to cover the electric aggregator application.

In order to complete your application you should respond to each of the issues listed above. When responding, address your letter to Debra Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.
