

Re: DE 13-216, David Gould Request for Class II Eligibility for a Residential Photovoltaic Array, Named Pennacook, Pursuant to RSA 362-F

Dear Mr. Gould:

On July 25, 2013, the Commission received an application from David Gould (Gould) requesting Class II certification pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law, for a 0.025 megawatt photovoltaic (PV) array, named Pennacook, located in Candia, NH. Staff has determined the application was complete in the initial filing in accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2500. The application and all submitted information have been reviewed and staff recommends approval effective July 25, 2013.

Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies and to have initiated operation after January 01, 2006. The application indicates that the Gould-Pennacook PV array began operation on May 31, 2013; the total nameplate capacity of the PV array is 0.025 MW. The facility's New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON37975.

Pursuant to Puc 2502.13, the Gould-Pennacook PV array is a customer-sited photovoltaic facility; therefore, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Paul Button will serve as the facility's independent monitor pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has determined that all necessary information has been provided to demonstrate the Gould-Pennacook PV array's eligibility for certification to produce New Hampshire Class II RECs. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby certifies the Gould-Pennacook PV array as a Class II renewable energy source effective July 25, 2013. The New Hampshire single certification code for the Gould-Pennacook PV array is NH-II-13-081.

Attached please find a copy of the notice of this certification provided to the GIS administrator.



Please be advised that, pursuant to RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the David Gould (Gould) residential photovoltaic (PV) array, named Pennacook, located at 81 Hall's Mill Road, Candia, NH as a Class II renewable energy source effective July 25, 2013. Accordingly, the Gould-Pennacook array is eligible to be issued New Hampshire Class II renewable energy certificates.

The Gould-Pennacook array has a total nameplate capacity of 0.025 megawatts. Paul Button will serve as the facility's independent monitor pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5). The applicant's NEPOOL GIS facility code is NON37975. The facility's New Hampshire certification code is NH-II-13-081.
