

I am a registered non-NEPOOL solar generator located in Candia, NH. My system came on-line in July of 2013 and I accumulated 13 REC's for the year. I was notified on June 13 of the impending retirement of my certificates on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Unfortunately, I am new to the process, and I was unaware of this impending deadline. I tried to find a buyer for my REC's but given the short notice and weekend timing I was not successful. I write to you with the hope that you would be willing to reinstate my RECs for the purpose of New Hampshire RPS-compliant banking. I would anticipate this being a one-time request now that am I aware of the annual deadline. The REC's and certificate numbers of interest are enclosed with this letter. I attest that the certificates noted in the enclosure (the 13 REC's from 2013) have not otherwise been, nor will be sold, retired, claimed, used, or represented as part of electrical energy output or sales, or used to satisfy obligations, in a jurisdiction other than New Hampshire. A notarized copy of this attestation will be forwarded via mail.
