Dear Mr. Leibman:

On August 13, 2013, REP Energy, LLC submitted an application with the Commission to register as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). The application is incomplete and does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003. In particular, Commission Staff reviewed the filing and identified the following items which are missing from the application.

- 1) Proof of EDI testing with each distribution utility that the applicant intends to do business with.

Puc 2003.01(d)(1) Demonstration of technical ability to provide for the efficient and reliable transfer of data and electronic information between utilities and the CEPS in the form of:

(a) A statement from each utility with which the CEPS intends to do business indicating that the applicant has complied with the training and testing requirements for electronic data interchange.

(c) A statement from each utility with which the CEPS does or intends to do business indicating that the applicant has successfully demonstrated electronic transaction capability.

- 2) Certificate from the Secretary of State showing that the applicant is authorized to do business in New Hampshire is missing.


(9) A copy of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state, if anything other than an individual.

3) Proof of financial surety.

Puc 2003.01(d)(4) Evidence of financial surety, as defined in Puc 2003.03.

In order to complete your application you should respond accordingly to each of the items listed above. When responding, address your letter to Debra Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.
