On March 31, 2014, REP Energy, LLC (REP Energy), a competitive electric power supplier currently authorized to operate only in the franchise areas of Liberty Utilities, New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, and Unitil Energy Systems, filed a request to expand its service territory to include the franchise area of PSNH. REP Energy provided a copy of a certificate demonstrating that it had completed electronic data interchange (EDI) testing with PSNH.

Staff reviewed the information in the request and believes REP Energy's filing meets the requirements to extend its service territory into the franchise area of PSNH. Staff, therefore, recommends that the Commission approve REP Energy's request to include the franchise area of PSNH in its service territory.
