Dear Mrs. Howland,

In response to the ISO-NE Market Participant Suspension, REP Energy has completed the necessary requirements with NE-ISO to ensure that REP Energy remains registered as a competitive power supplier in the state of New Hampshire.

On December 18, 2014 REP Energy completed the Load Asset Registration Forms (LARF) process for New Hampshire utilities which were assigned new Load Asset IDs. NHEC was assigned the following Load Asset IDs: 46935, 46936 and 46937; PSNH was assigned 46939; Liberty Utilities was assigned 46938; Unitil was assigned 46944.

The company status was never compromised and has and always has been in good standing during the letter of credit period. Accordingly the letter of credits had not been drawn against and the letters of credits remain in full force and effect.

All of the REP Energy customers for the state of New Hampshire were scheduled to have December Meter Read starts, and will be moved accordingly to a January start as REP Energy has obtained consent from these new customers and did not begin a December flow.
