Re: DE 13-248, Public Service Company of New Hampshire Petition to Amend Rate EOL to Include Light Emitting Diode Technology Joint Request to Approve Settlement and Revised Rate

Dear Director Howland:

On January 21, 2014, the Commission issued a secretarial letter granting a joint request of the City of Manchester ("City") and Public Service Company of New Hampshire ("PSNH") to suspend the procedural schedule in the above-referenced docket to permit the City and PSNH time to determine whether a settlement could be achieved. The City and PSNH engaged in extensive negotiations and have reached a settlement on issues specific to the City. That settlement is enclosed with this submission. In addition, PSNH is proposing to make more general amendments its initial proposal for including light emitting diode technology under Rate EOL, as set out in the enclosed testimony of Charles R. Goodwin. By this filing, the City and PSNH jointly request that the Commission resume the docket and approve both the proposed amendments to PSNH's Rate EOL proposal, as well as the settlement agreement between the City and PSNH.
