It is our information that the project will be out to bid in September, 2013, with construction intended to start on November 1, 2013. Therefore, we would appreciate any steps which can be taken at the Commission to expedite the handling of this Petition to allow PSNH's crossing work to be commenced consistent with the construction start date of the NHDOT's project.
