Dear Mr. Hirsh:

On September 11, 2013, Solar Farm Bank submitted an application on behalf of George R. Rickley (Rickley) requesting Commission approval for Class II New Hampshire REC eligibility for his residential photovoltaic (PV) array pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Certification of this facility will enable Solar Farm Bank to add the Rickley facility to its aggregation pursuant to Puc 2506.01 and recognized by the Generation Information System (GIS) under NON 35889.

Staff has reviewed the Rickley application and has recommended approval of the Rickley PV array as eligible to be aggregated by the Solar Farm Bank for Class II RECs effective September 11, 2013, the date Staff was able to determine that the application was complete.


Since this facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Paul Button, Energy Audits Unlimited, will monitor the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Button will report the facility's total output annually to the customer, the Commission and the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of the Solar Farm Bank's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).

The details for the Rickley facility are listed in the following table.
