Dear Mr. McNeil:

On November 25, 2013, the Commission received applications from the New Hampshire Electric Cooperative (NHEC) requesting approval of the following entities for their photovoltaic (PV) arrays to produce Class II Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire’s Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law:¹ Sam Kinney (Kinney); Shipp Webb (Webb); Bill Morse (Morse); David Tofts (Tofts); Declan O’Connell (O’Connell) and, Declan O’Connell/Dragonfly Yoga (Dragonfly Yoga).

Staff has reviewed these applications and has recommended approval of these PV arrays as eligible for Class II RECs as listed in the following table:


¹ Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies that began operation after January 1, 2006 (RSA 362-F:4, II).

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Since these facilities are customer-sited sources, the output is not recorded in the New England Power Pool Market Settlement System and, as a result the output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Your application states that NHEC will monitor the facilities' output as required by N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. The total output from these facilities will be included as part of the NHEC Class II Aggregation's total output reported to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as approved by the Commission on April 9, 2010.

The Commission has determined that NHEC has provided all the information necessary to demonstrate these facilities' eligibility for certification and hereby certifies the above named photovoltaic arrays as eligible for Class II RECs effective as of November 25, 2013.
