SUBJECT: DT 14-152, Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement between TDS Telecom and Sprint Spectrum, L.P.

TO: Debra Howland, Executive Director

On June 5, 2014, TDS Telecom (Hollis Telephone Company, Kearsarge Telephone Company, Merrimack County Telephone Company, Union Telephone Company and Wilton Telephone Company) filed a new Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement (Agreement) between TDS Telecom and Sprint Spectrum, L.P. The filing notes the Agreement was arrived at through voluntary negotiations and requests approval pursuant to Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Pursuant to § 252(e), a State Commission may only reject an agreement adopted by negotiation when the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or implementation of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest. Staff reviewed the Agreement and recommends that the Commission allow this Agreement to go into effect by operation of law 90 days after originally having been filed. In this case, the Agreement would become effective on or about September 3, 2014.
