On June 5, 2014, TDS Telecom filed a Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement (Agreement) with Sprint Spectrum, L.P. The petition was filed for approval pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). The Agreement sets forth terms and conditions that will facilitate the provision of wireless telecommunications service by Sprint Spectrum, L.P.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC §252(e)(4), the Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing, on or about September 3, 2014. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.
