Dear Director Howland:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES"), enclosed please find an original and six (6) copies of UES's revision to the proposed August 1, 2014 External Delivery Charge ("EDC"). This revision was premarked as Exhibit 3 at the July 23, 2014 hearing in the above referenced docket, and consists of 23 pages.

The revised pages have been Bates Stamped to correspond to the original June 17th filing for ease of review and replacement. The revisions reflect the removal of the proposed lost distribution revenue of \$18,724, pursuant to the Company's motion, which was unopposed by the Staff and OCA and accepted by the Commission during the July 23rd hearing.

In addition to the amended tariff pages enclosed, due to removing recovery of lost base revenue through the EDC at this time, UES is no longer seeking approval of changes to its External Delivery Charge tariff, Schedule EDC, which was part of the June 17, 2014 filing. In summary, UES respectfully request approval of the following tariffs for effect August 1, 2014:
