## Summary

On June 30, 2014, the Commission received an application filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC<sup>1</sup> (Knollwood Energy) for Benjamin Brown (Brown). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for the Brown photovoltaic (PV) array<sup>2</sup> and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation.

The Commission, in a non-adjudicative process, is required to issue a determination of whether a facility meets a particular classification within 45 days of receipt of a completed application. The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the application, Staff recommends that the Commission certify the Brown array as an eligible facility for Class II RECs to be included as part of the Knollwood aggregation effective as of June 30, 2014.

#### Analysis

To qualify as a REC eligible facility, Puc 2505.08 (b) requires the source to provide the following information:

#### Recommendation

Staff has reviewed the application for the Brown PV array and participation in the Knollwood Energy aggregation and can affirm it is complete pursuant to Puc 2505.08. Staff has determined that this facility meets the requirements for certification as a Class II renewable energy source. Staff recommends Commission approval for the Brown PV array as an eligible Class II facility to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation, effective as of June 30, 2014.
