Northland Telephone Company of Maine, Inc. d/b/a FairPoint Communications ("FairPoint") is filing for effect July 31, 2014 tariff changes consisting of:



This filing makes certain changes when a customer adds a Custom Calling Feature. Presently, FairPoint charges a Service Order Issuance Charge and a Central Office Connection Charge to add Custom Calling Services to its customers' lines. FairPoint will no longer charge the Service Order Issuance charge and will only charge the Central Office Connection charge when activating Custom Calling Services.

In addition, this filing also changes the name Central Office Work Charge to Central Office Connection Charge, matching the verbiage as it appears on customers' bills. This tariff filing also corrects the Non-Recurring Charge for Fixed Call Forwarding and Simultaneous Call Forwarding. FairPoint will only be charging a Central Office Connection Charge to activate those features, as noted above.
