Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Granite State Electric d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("the Company"), I am writing to inform the Commission that, as detailed in Section IV.C of the 2015-2016 New Hampshire Statewide CORE Energy Efficiency Plan approved by the Commission in its Order No. 25,747 dated December 31, 2014 in Docket DE 14-216, the Company is notifying interested parties of its intention to transfer funds within the Residential sector of its CORE electric energy efficiency programs in order to meet the demand for its Home Performance with Energy Star program.

The table below reflects the approved budgets for the 2015 CORE New Hampshire Energy Efficiency programs and the transfers. As noted in the table, the Company is requesting to transfer \$32,000 from the ENERGY STAR Products Program into the Home Performance with Energy Star Program. The transfer from the ENERGY STAR Products Program constitutes 7.7% of its respective budget. However, the budget transfer into the Home Performance with Energy Star Program budget represents a 12.0% increase.

The Company has experienced strong demand for weatherization projects in its Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program during the year. In addition, the Company has also experienced slight underperformance within its ENERGY STAR Products program and wants to leverage those funds to provide incentives for additional electric heat participants through Home Performance with ENERGY STAR in 2015.
