Renewal of Registration to Provide Electric Aggregation Service

On September 9, 2014, Utility Choice Savings, LLC (UCS) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. USC's registration had expired on September 11, 2014. On September 19, 2014, UCS provided additional information to complete its application.

Staff has reviewed the information in the application and determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), USC's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before July 13, 2014. Because this is the first time UCS has been late with its submission to renew its registration for electric load aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve UCS's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective September 11, 2014, for a term of 5 years.
