On January 22, 2015, Agera Energy LLC (Agera), a competitive electric power supplier currently authorized to operate in the franchise areas of Liberty Utilities and Public Service Company of New Hampshire, filed a request to expand its service territory to include the franchise area of Unitil Energy Systems (UES). Agera provided a copy of a certificate demonstrating that it had completed electronic data interchange (EDI) testing with UES.

Staff reviewed the information in the request and believes Agera's filing meets the requirements to extend its service territory into the franchise area of UES. Staff, therefore, recommends that the Commission approve Agera's request to include the franchise area of UES in its service territory.
