

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**SUPREME COURT**

In Case No. 2016-0002, Appeal of Pipe Line Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc., the court on February 18, 2016, issued the following order:

Motion for summary disposition is denied.

Appeal from a decision of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission is accepted and will be scheduled for oral argument before the full court.

This case appears to be eligible for mediation pursuant to Rule 12-A. Under Rule 12-A(2), the agreement of all parties is required for appellate mediation. If all parties in this case agree to participate in mediation, Pipe Line Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc. shall submit the completed Appellate Mediation Agreement form to the court on or before March 4, 2016. An Appellate Mediation Agreement form (NHJB-2614-SUP) is being provided to Pipe Line Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc. with this order. If an Appellate Mediation Agreement form is not filed, an order will be issued regarding further proceedings.

If Attorney Richard A. Kanoff or Attorney Saqib Hossain intends to participate in this case on behalf of Pipe Line Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc., each attorney intending to participate shall file a verified application to appear pro hac vice in accordance with Rule 33(1) on or before March 4, 2016. The application should be accompanied by the non-refundable application fee of \$250.00 or by evidence that the fee was previously paid in a related or consolidated matter. See Rule 33(5).
