On May 2, 2016, First Point Power, LLC (First Point Power), a competitive electric power supplier currently authorized to operate in the franchise areas of Liberty Utilities, Public Service Company of New Hampshire, d/b/a Eversource Energy, and Unitil Energy Systems, filed a request to expand its service territory to include the franchise area of New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NHEC). First Point Power provided a copy of a certificate demonstrating that it had completed electronic data interchange (EDI) testing with NHEC.

Staff reviewed the information in the request and believes First Point Power's filing meets the requirements to extend its service territory into the franchise area of NHEC. Staff, therefore, recommends that the Commission approve First Point Power's request to include the franchise area of NHEC in its service territory.
