Deficiency Letter - Request for Additional Information

Dear Mr. Anderson:

On March 7, 2016, Anderson Energy Solutions, LLC (Anderson Energy) submitted an application to the Commission for registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Commission Staff has reviewed the application and determined it is incomplete and therefore does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003. In particular, Staff identified the following requirement that has not been met and the related item which is missing from the application:

1) Either a) a recent printout of applicant's listing on the N.H. Secretary of State website with the status shown as "Good Standing" or words of similar import or b) a certificate from the Secretary of State (SOS) showing that the applicant is authorized to do business in New Hampshire.

Puc 2006.02 Form for Initial and Renewal of Aggregators. (5) A copy of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state, if anything other than an individual.

In order to complete your application, you should respond accordingly to the item listed above. When responding, please address your letter to Debra A. Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.

Pursuant to Puc 2003.04 (h), please provide all information requested within 60 days of the date of this later, on or before **June 18, 2016**. Puc 2003.04 (h) is copied below.

Puc 2003.04(h) If the commission has requested information or clarification to complete an application for registration, and such information or clarification is not provided within 60 days of the request, the commission shall suspend the application. If, after 120 days of the date of the request, the applicant has not provided the requested information or clarification, the commission shall reject the application. If an application is rejected, the application fee shall be forfeited and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application and fee prior to acting as a CEPS in New Hampshire.
