On June 1, 2016, the Commission held a prehearing conference in the above-captioned docket Pursuant to Order No. 25,900 (May 12, 2016). The Office of Consumer Advocate filed a letter of participation pursuant to RSA 363:28 on May 2, 2016.

Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. included a proposed tariff charge for certain customer-sited distributed generation. Certain parties filed motions to intervene based on their interest in this proposed tariff.
