Re: DE 16-576, Development of New Alternative Net Metering Tariffs and/or Other Regulatory Mechanisms and Tariffs for Customer-Generators Granting Interventions and Scheduling Further Technical Session

To the Parties:

On June 10, 2016, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the above-referenced matter. Appearances were entered by the three regulated electric distribution utilities, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, and a number of prospective interveners.

Petitions to intervene were filed by Borrego Solar Systems, Inc., Granite State Hydropower Association, the Office of Energy and Planning, The Jordan Institute, ReVision Energy, LLC, Northeast Clean Energy Council, the City of Nashua, Freedom Logistics, LLC d/b/a Freedom Energy Logistics, Acadia Center, Conservation Law Foundation, Solar Endeavors, LLC, Energy Freedom Coalition of America, City of Lebanon, Barrington Power, LLC, Norwich Technologies, New England Ratepayers Association, Standard Power of America, Inc., New Hampshire Sustainable Energy Association, The Nature Conservancy, Energy Emporium, LLC, The Consumer Energy Alliance, South Pack Solar, Lee W. Oxenham, Revolution Energy, LLC, and The Alliance for Solar Choice.

No party objected to any of these intervention requests. The Commission has granted all of the petitions to intervene.

A further technical session has been scheduled to be held in this proceeding at the Commission's offices on June 22, 2016 beginning at 9:00 a.m.
