REVISION ENERGY, LLC's PETITION TO INTERVENE

ReVision Energy, LLC (ReVision") submits this Petition for Intervention in the above referenced docket, and states the following:

1. ReVision is a full service renewable energy contracting company that provides engineering, design, installation and equipment service for homes, businesses, municipal buildings and nonprofits. ReVision's mission is to help the people and businesses of New Hampshire transition away from fossil fuels to sustainable, zero-emission, renewable solar energy.
2. ReVision has offices in Exeter and Concord, New Hampshire and Portland and Liberty Maine. Since 2010, ReVision has installed thousands of grid-tied solar photovoltaic energy systems in New Hampshire. ReVision has over 120 employees, almost half of whom live or work in New Hampshire.
3. ReVision was actively involved in the legislative process leading to passage of HB 1116, which mandated initiation of the current docket.
4. ReVision has a direct, personal pecuniary interest in the development and implementation of new alternative net metering tariffs.
5. ReVision's participation in the proceeding is in the interest of justice and will not disrupt the orderly conduct of this proceeding, or delay the proceedings.

Therefore, ReVision Energy, LLC, respectfully requests that it be granted full intervenor status in this proceeding.
