Recently Eversource and Hydro-Quebec submitted an application to the New Hampshire PUC for their Purchase Power Agreement (PPA) for Northern Pass, making many claims that the project will benefit NH. Here are the real facts around that PPA:

An Unfair Share: Northern Pass states that the PPA "guarantees Eversource NH customers will receive their share of the power from Northern Pass," making this sound like a great deal for us, right? WRONG. We are getting nothing more than what we are already entitled to as the minimum amount of energy share mandated by ISO New England. Not only that, but this energy is only going to Eversource customers while the rest of New Hampshire has to live with these ugly towers ruining our natural heritage.
