On August 18, 2016, Broker Online Exchange, LLC (Broker Online Exchange) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Broker Online Exchange's currently effective registration expires on August 28, 2016.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Broker Online Exchange's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before June 29, 2016. Broker Online Exchange asked that the Commission excuse the lateness of its filing and stated that its processes have been updated to ensure renewals occur in a manner complying with Puc 2003.05(a). Staff recommends the Commission grant a waiver of Puc 2003.05(a) and approve Broker Online Exchange's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective August 28, 2016, for a term of five years.
