**Joint Petition to Establish Interconnection/Transition Fund for

NOW COMES, Angela J. Ford and respectfully moves the Commission grant her intervention in this matter, pursuant to RSA 541-A:32 and Puc 203.17, and states as follows:

1. Petitioner resides in a residential home located at 77 Pleasant Street in Concord, and receives heat through Concord Steam.
2. Petitioner is a non-governmental Concord Steam customer that needs to transition off of Concord Steam service, at an estimated cost of about \$10,000 and having a direct and considerable impact on limited household finances.
