

On December 22, 2016, IDT Energy Network, LLC (IDT) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. IDT's currently effective registration expires on March 9, 2017.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete. Staff recommends that the Commission approve IDT's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective March 9, 2017, for a term of five years.
