Dear Ms. Howland:

In Order No. 26,086, the Commission approved the request for Energy Service rates associated with the Company's Energy Service Solicitation for rates effective February 1 – July 31, 2018. This rate change results in an increase of 1.58%, or \$1.87 for a residential customer taking energy service using 650 kilowatt-hours per month.

The compliance tariff pages were filed on December 21, 2018, but on January 2, 2018, Order No. 26,095 was issued in Docket No. DE 17-136 for rates effective January 1, 2018, which changed the System Benefits Charge, thus changing the total rates effective on February 1, 2018.
