On June 26, 2017, Choose Energy, Inc. (Choose Energy) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Choose Energy's currently effective registration expires on August 18, 2017.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Choose Energy's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before June 19, 2017. Choose Energy discussed with Staff and stated in its application that filing the renewal application with the Commission is a priority, but that it recently underwent a merger and, because it is in a transition period, it missed the filing deadline. Staff recommends the Commission grant a waiver of Puc 2003.05(a) and approve Choose Energy's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective August 18, 2017, for a term of five years.
