New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission 21 S. Fruit Street, Suite 10 Concord, NH 03301 RE: DW 17-114 Eversource Energy Acquisition of Aquarion Water Company Reconsideration of petition of Rep. Mindi Messmer to represent Rye Aquarion customers. To the Public Utilities Commission: I am an Aquarion Water Company customer residing on Pine Street in the Jenness Beach area of Rye. Mindi Messmer is my State Representative. Because Mindi is not an Aquarion Water customer (but is an Eversource Energy customer), the Commission has not allowed her standing to represent Rye Aquarion customers like me in this matter. Given her status as our elected representative, in addition to her professional and scientific expertise in hydro geology and regulatory science/medicine, I respectfully request that she be allowed to represent me. My concern is that Eversource has never owned a water company. If this deal is approved, Eversource would be acquiring a company with emerging and serious water quality and capacity issues that they have never dealt with before. A full, open and transparent hearing with all relevant stakeholders, including Rye Aquarion customers and their elected state officials, is in my view appropriate. I respectfully request that Rep. Mindi

Messmer's petition to represent Rye Aquarion customers be reconsidered and that she be granted standing to represent me in this matter. Yours truly,
