Conservation Law Foundation's Letter to Commission Regarding CLF Response**

Dear Chairman Goldner,

On June 9, 2023, Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF") filed an objection to the request filed by Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("Liberty") requesting that the Commission close the instant docket and consider Liberty's Phase 2 Battery Storage Pilot program in Liberty's general rate case, Docket No. DE 23-039. In its objection, CLF respectfully requests that the Commission deny Liberty's request and, instead, consider Liberty's Phase 2 Battery Storage Pilot in this existing docket.

Since filing the objection, it has been brought to CLF's attention that CLF mistakenly stated in the objection that the City of Lebanon did not join the Settlement Agreement in Docket No. 17-189.
