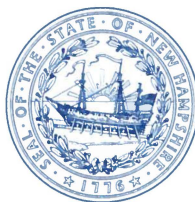

To the Parties:

By secretarial letter dated December 5, 2018, the Commission granted a motion to amend procedural schedule filed by Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities (Liberty) in Docket No. DG 17-198. In doing so, the Commission suspended the procedural schedules in both Docket No. DG 17-198 and related Docket No. DG 17-152 until January 31, 2019, the deadline for Liberty's supplemental filing in Docket No. DG 17-198, as described in the December 5, 2018 secretarial letter.

Liberty filed a second motion to amend procedural schedule on January 30, 2019, which requests an extension of the deadline for its supplemental filing to March 15, 2019. Liberty states that it requires additional time to obtain accurate and detailed construction estimates for the Granite Bridge pipeline and Granite Bridge LNG facility projects to which these dockets relate. Liberty noted in its motion that Commission Staff, the Office of the Consumer Advocate, the Town of Epping, and Repsol Energy North America Corporation assent to the relief requested, and none of the remaining parties has objected.

Based on Liberty's representation regarding party positions on the motion and the absence of any objections, the Commission has granted Liberty's request to establish March 15, 2019, as the date on or before which Liberty will make its supplemental filing in DG 17-198. *See* N.H. Code of Admin. R. Puc 202.04. Accordingly, the procedural schedules for both DG 17-198 and DG 17-152 are suspended until Liberty makes its supplemental filing and a new, agreed upon schedule is proposed by the parties.
