Re: DG 17-198, Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities
Petition to Approve Firm Supply, Transportation Agreements and the Granite Bridge
Project

To the Parties:

On December 13, 2018, Constellation LNG, LLC (CLNG) filed a motion for leave to intervene out-of-time in Docket No. DG 17-198 as the assignee of a delivered supply contract between ENGIE Gas and LNG, LLC (ENGIE) and Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. (Liberty) that is under review in this docket. ENGIE filed a notice on December 18, 2018 that it was withdrawing its intervention in this proceeding based on the intervention request of its assignee, CLNG.

Liberty stated that it does not object to CLNG's motion to intervene. No other responses to that motion have been filed.

The Commission previously granted ENGIE's timely petition to intervene in Order No. 26,135 (May 18, 2018), noting that ENGIE was a party to a contract at issue. *See id.* at 5-6. It stated that all parties "will be limited in discovery requests, testimony, cross-examination, and legal briefings, to the evaluation of Liberty's analysis and support for its proposed contracts and projects, and the interest of Liberty customers in the prudence, justness, and reasonableness of those contracts and projects." *Id.* at 6.

The Commission has granted CLNG's request to intervene in this proceeding as ENGIE's assignee, finding that CLNG meets the standards for intervention in RSA 541-A:32. *See* N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 203.17. CLNG's participation in this proceeding will be subject to the conditions stated in Order No. 26,135. In addition, CLNG shall comply with the supplemental order of notice dated April 3, 2019.
