Dear Mr. Cannel:

On April 25, 2018, C.N. Brown Electricity, LLC d/b/a C.N. Brown Energy (C.N. Brown) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on May 3, 2018 recommending approval of C.N. Brown's registration renewal application for a two-year term beginning on July 19, 2018, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.06(e)(1).

Your application for registration renewal is approved effective as of July 19, 2018, under Puc 2003.06(e)(1). The renewed registration is for a term of two years and expires at the close of business on July 19, 2020. Pursuant to Puc 2003.06(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before May 20, 2020.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at:

Please note that, effective as of July 1, 2014, each registered electric load aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
