

Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing to advise the Commission in the above Docket that Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) inadvertently missed the deadline established in the Commission’s Order *Nisi* No. 26,190, dated November 14, 2018 (the “Order”), to provide a copy of the Order to all owners of the land bordering the public waters at the location of the crossing. (Please note that Eversource did provide the required notification to the Town Clerk of Gilford, the New Hampshire Attorney General and NHDES in a timely manner under the Order). The Order established November 26, 2018 as the date by which such landowner notification was to be provided. To correct this deficiency, Eversource has today sent, by overnight mail delivery, a copy of the Order with covering letter to each of the relevant landowners. This fact will be documented by the affidavit filed with the Commission pursuant to the terms of the Order on or before December 10, 2018.
