On December 20, 2018, Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a Consolidated Communications-NNE (“CCI”) filed a request for approval of Amendment 1 to the Interconnection Agreement between CCI and Time Warner Cable Information Services, LLC, under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Staff notes that the underlying Interconnection Agreement was between Verizon and Time Warner Cable Information Services (New Hampshire), LLC, considered in Docket No. DT 05-081 and effective by operation of law on or about July 22, 2005. The agreement can be found on the Commission’s web pages at <http://www.puc.state.nh.us/Telecom/interconnectionagreements.htm>.

Time Warner Cable Information Services, LLC is a registered telecommunications carrier (a provider of only VOIP or IP-enabled services) in New Hampshire.

The purpose of this amendment is to align the contract with a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) order released November 11, 2011¹, which provides that all “price-cap” local exchange carriers’ non-access reciprocal compensation rates shall be set pursuant to “bill and keep” arrangements after July 1, 2018. The amendment states that this provision represents a change in law.

Staff recommends that the adoption of this amendment to the Interconnection Agreement be allowed to go into effect by operation of law, 90 days after the date of the original filing.
