Qualified Capital Project Annual Adjustment Charge**


Dear Ms. Howland:

On February 11, 2019, Pennichuck Water Works filed its 2019 Petition of Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. for Qualified Capital Project Annual Adjustment Charge. Attached to that Petition as Exhibits 1-2 were schedules describing capital expenditures for 2018-2021. In those schedules, the full cost of a portion of the PWW-PEU Interconnect was allocated to PWW alone instead of being split between PWW and PEU. Specifically, the \$67,850 allocated to capital expenditures for 2018 for the "Mast Road Replacement (PEU-PWW) Interconnection" should have been allocated 50% to PWW, or \$33,925.

An original and six copies of the corrected Exhibits 1-2 are attached to this letter and should replace the Exhibits 1-2 filed on February 11, 2019.
