This letter will serve as a follow-up status report on the parties' ongoing negotiations in the above referenced Docket. By correspondence dated January 17, 2020, I provided on behalf of Consolidated Communications a status report concerning the parties' continuing negotiations and advised that a further report would be forthcoming. After consultation with counsel to the various CLEC parties to this Docket, Consolidated does not anticipate that all matters will be resolved via a mutual settlement agreement. Therefore, Consolidated requests that the Commission schedule a status conference for the purposes of (i) establishing a schedule to bring this Docket to an adjudicated conclusion and (ii) allow the parties to brief the Commission and Staff on any further progress on settlement. In the meantime, the parties will continue negotiations and attempt to develop a mutually agreeable litigation schedule.
