PETITION FOR INTERVENENOR STATUS

In accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice, PUC 203.17, the CLEC Association of Northern New England, Inc., which includes CRC Communications LLC d/b/a OTELCO, FirstLight Fiber, and Biddeford Internet Corp. d/b/a Great Works Internet (collectively "CANNE") hereby petition the Commission for permission to participate in this proceeding as an intervening party.

CANNE is a not for profit association of facilities-based competitive local exchange carriers in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont. CANNE members that operate in New Hampshire have interconnection arrangements with Consolidated Communications of Northern New England, LLC ("Consolidated").
