# DE 19-051 Reliability Enhancement Plan and Vegetation Management Plan Report

### **REQUEST:**

In reference to Bates page 4 and beginning on line 22, the Company states that the CY2018 final VMP budget was reduced at Staff's request. Liberty's VMP budget was \$1,677,086 after anticipated payment from Consolidated Communications. Is it Liberty's understanding that Staff agreed that a CY 2018 budget of \$1,677,086 was appropriate? Please explain.

#### **RESPONSE:**

The Company submitted its original budget of \$1,851,000 (see spreadsheet below) based on its assessment of the trimming and reliability needs of the distribution system given the four-year trim cycle and the requirements of Puc 307.10. PUC Staff was not in favor of the original submitted budget and requested that the Company reduce it. Subsequently, Liberty reduced the budget by approximately 9% to \$1,677,086 and provided that reduced budget to Staff. Staff did not agree that the \$1,677,086 budget was appropriate, and requested that it be further lowered. There was never any agreement on a budget amount.

In accordance with the terms of the REP/VMP:

Granite State will provide its REP and VMP Plans to Staff for the following fiscal year for Staff's review. Granite State will meet with Staff in technical sessions to discuss the Plans, obtain comments, and answer any questions regarding the plan to be implemented for the subsequent fiscal year. After review by Staff, Granite State will take all reasonable steps it deems appropriate to carry out and implement the Plans, taking into account the comments of Staff. Review by Staff of the Plans does not relieve Granite State of its obligation to operate its business and maintain safe, reliable service through expenditures and other capital investments in the ordinary course of business that are not set forth in the Plans, nor does it bind Staff to a particular position regarding the adequacy and/or effectiveness of the Plans.

In accordance with the above terms, while it is certainly preferable to come to agreement on the budget, such agreement is not necessary. Nevertheless, the Company has the "obligation to operate its business and maintain safe, reliable service through expenditures and other capital investments in the ordinary course of business that are not

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set forth in the Plans." Given the conditions experienced on the distribution system during 2018, the Company spent the funds it deemed necessary, appropriate, and prudent to maintain safe and reliable service.
