Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Procedural Order Re: Request for Hybrid Hearing issued in these matters on January 5, 2022, the Department of Energy (Department) notifies the Commission that it intends to participate remotely in all three of the hearings.

Additionally, the Department recommends that the Commission conduct these three hearings (all scheduled for January 14, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.) sequentially, in numerical order, such that the full hearing in DE 19-057 would be conducted starting at 9 a.m., followed by the full hearing for DE 21-029, and then the full hearing for DE 21-117. Establishing a hearing sequence in advance will allow the Department and likely also other parties to schedule their resources more efficiently.
