In Case No. 2021-0498, <u>Appeal of Public Service Company</u> of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, the court on July 7, 2023, issued the following order:

The parties' joint motion for limited remand is granted as follows. The case is remanded to the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") to consider a settlement reached by the parties, and to issue an appropriate order. The appeal is stayed pending the remand. The parties shall inform the court of the status of the proceedings before the Commission on the thirtieth day of each month. If, on remand, the settlement proposal is accepted by the Commission, this appeal will be withdrawn by Eversource Energy. If the settlement is rejected by the Commission, the limited remand will end, and the appeal shall resume before this court.

This order is entered by a single justice (Bassett, J.). See Rule 21(7).
