Application to Renew Registration as Provider of Natural Gas Aggregation Service

Dear Mr Rounds:

On April 25, 2019 Standard Power of America, Inc. (Standard Power) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on April 26, 2019, in which it confirmed its review of the application and its conclusion that the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000. Staff recommended that Standard Power's registration application be approved for a five-year term, beginning on June 8, 2019.

The Commission has approved Staff's recommendation. Accordingly, Standard Power's application for registration is approved, effective as of June 8, 2019. The renewed registration is for a term of five years and expires at the close of business on June 8, 2024. Pursuant to Puc 3003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before April 9, 2024.

Please be aware that registered providers of natural gas aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC3000.pdf>.

Please note that each registered natural gas aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
