Dear Mr. Hussey:

On May 13, 2019, Stanley Energy (Stanley Energy) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service.


Commission Staff filed a memorandum on May 15, 2019, in which it confirmed its review of the application and its conclusion that the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000. Staff recommended that Stanley Energy's registration application be approved for a five-year term, beginning July 20, 2019.

The Commission has approved Staff's recommendation. Accordingly, Stanley Energy's application for registration is approved, effective as of July 20, 2019. The renewed registration is for a term of five years and expires at the close of business on July 20, 2024. Pursuant to Puc 3003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before May 21, 2024.

Please be aware that registered providers of natural gas aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC3000.pdf>.

Please note that each registered natural gas aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
