Dear Director Howland:

On August 23, 2019, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource" or the "Company") made its initial submission in the above-referenced docket. That submission included a motion for confidential treatment of certain information identified in the filing.

On April 23, 2020, the Commission issued Order No. 26,350 granting, in part, and denying, in part, Eversource's motion. Additionally, the Commission determined that it lacked sufficient clarity to rule the confidentiality of certain of the information and directed Eversource to file a revised motion along with revised versions of initial documents where the redactions were modified to be consistent with Order No. 26,350. Enclosed for filing is the revised request as described by the Commission and it is accompanied by revised documents consistent with the Commission's ruling.

In addition to the revised motion and the revised Confidential and Redacted versions of its initial filing, enclosed is a Motion for Reconsideration and/or Clarification with respect to the Commission's rulings on Confidential Energy Infrastructure Information in Order No. 26,350.
