Summary of Order Nisi  
No. 26.355 Granting  
Crossing Licenses  
May 11, 2020

On May 11, 2020, the Commission approved a request by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) under RSA 371:17 for licenses to construct, maintain, and operate electric lines over and across the North Branch River in Hillsborough and Antrim, and over and across Steels Pond and state-owned land in Antrim. These crossings are modifications of existing crossings. The Commission's Order, the petition, and subsequent docket filings, other than any information for which confidential treatment is requested of or granted by the Commission, are posted at <https://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2019/19-149.html>.

The Commission determined that the proposed crossings are necessary to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public and that the licenses may be exercised without substantially affecting the public rights in the North Branch River, Steels Pond, or State-owned land at the crossing locations. The Commission approved Eversource's request subject to certain conditions related to the safe construction, operation, and maintenance of the proposed crossings.

The Commission delayed the effectiveness of its approval to ensure that the public receives notice of the Commission's determination and has an opportunity to request a hearing. Persons interested in responding to the Commission's action may submit their comments, or file a written request for a hearing that states the reason and basis for a hearing, no later than May 28, 2020. Any person(s) responding to such comments and requests for hearing shall do so no later than June 4, 2020. Following consideration of any comments and requests for hearing received, the Commission may further extend the final effective date of its Order. Unless the Commission orders otherwise, the Commission's Order shall become final and effective on June 11, 2020.

Some deals contain built-in traps that may lure declarer to an unnecessary defeat. For this reason, declarer should examine all his assets before committing himself to a play.

Take this case where South got to four hearts and West led the queen of clubs. Declarer won with the ace, cashed the ace of diamonds, drew two rounds of trump ending in his hand, then led the ten of diamonds and let it ride. East won with the queen, cashed the king of clubs and shifted to a spade, and West's A-Q of spades put the contract down one.

South bemoaned his bad luck in finding the queen of

diamonds and both missing spade honors offside. With proper play, however, the contract was a virtual certainty from the outset.

The fault lay in South's becoming overly enamored of dummy's diamond suit and the potential spade discard it afforded. Had he instead looked at the hand a whole, he would have realized that his spade holding was actually an asset rather than a liability.

The correct approach is to draw trump ending in dummy and lead a spade toward the K-10. After East follows low, South can either finesse the ten or play the king, depending on where he thinks the ace is located.

As it happens, both spade honors are offside, so declarer cannot avoid losing two spade tricks. Nevertheless, the contract is assured.

For example, suppose West wins the ten of spades with the queen, cashed the queen of clubs and shifts to a diamond. Declarer puts up the ace and plays a second spade to the king and ace, establishing dummy's jack. Whatever West returns, South cannot be stopped from discarding a diamond on the jack of spades, and he winds up losing only two spades and a club.
